

# GPABC Minutes

## May 13, 2009

**Meeting called to order** at 6:34 p.m. by President Johnny Gardetto.

### **Opening Statement** – Johnny Gardetto

- GPABC Board contact sheet was routed for attendance. There are many changes in sports rep positions, and board members must check attendance sheet for replacements and openings and verify contact information for new fiscal year.
- Special thanks were extended to Jeanine Bly for chairing the Scholarship Committee for the past two years. Jeanine has worked very hard to establish the application and award process. Her efforts will benefit the GPABC and GHS student athletes for many years.

### **Project selection** – Johnny Gardetto

- Weightlifting:** The officers spent a significant amount of time discussing Coach Bond's request for meet fees and transportation/lodging costs for an AAU power lifting event in August. The officers recommend denial of the request so as not to set a precedent for requests from other teams for these types of items. It is expected that parents of AAU athletes will cover these fees, not the GPABC and/or school district. Coach Bond was encouraged to submit project selection requests for equipment and/or training that would benefit the weight lifters, as well as all GHS athletes.
- Reminder:** Fall sports coaches' project selection requests are due by June 1<sup>st</sup> to Gina Wilkins. Fall sports reps should talk with their coaches about the requests and function of the GPABC.

### **AD Update** –Gina Wilkins

- Baseball starts on May 15<sup>th</sup>; there is a large group interested in playing this year.
- Physicals and forms for Fall Sports:** Physical and other forms are available on the district's website. Information for low cost physicals through the district will also be posted there.
- CNI awards banquet:** Several student athletes from Greendale have been invited to participate at the CNI banquet honoring athletes from the 2008-09 school year.
- Calendar Raffle:** Other area schools have sponsored this type of raffle to raise money. Each school day has a raffle amount set and a winner is chosen each day. Only parents, not students, can sell the calendars. Greg Turay would need to obtain a license for the club. Concern was raised as to whether a participant would have to pay for the calendar or just ask for one. Gina will check on that question. This may also be used as a replacement for the Gold C card football fund raiser, but if any sports reps are interested in chairing this fund raiser, please contact Johnny, Gina or Gail.
