

# GPABC Minutes

## November 11, 2009

Meeting called to order at 6:31 pm by President Johnny Gardetto

**October minutes** – Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved minutes from meeting of October 14, 2009. Minutes are posted on the website, [www.greendaleboosterclub.org](http://www.greendaleboosterclub.org).

### Opening Statement – Johnny Gardetto

**Special Thanks** – A huge thank you to **Cindy Connell** and her husband **Kevin** for a successful fall concession season and 6 years as our outdoor concessions coordinator. Cindy scrambled to put together two more games for visiting playoff teams so a big thanks to all of those who helped with concessions for those additional playoff games.

Special thanks to Gina Wilkins for her ability to organize our field and therefore our outdoor concessions for two additional playoff games. The schools involved were very appreciative as Johnny read a thank you letter from the AD at South Milwaukee.

### Project selection – Gina Wilkins

**Boys Basketball** has received all items except warm-ups, which will be here before the season starts.

**Girls basketball** is waiting on team bags.

**Containers** have been ordered for use in organizing all supplies for the sports

**Wrestling** had to get replacement 'dummies' as the one received was not what they wanted.

- A vote was taken and approved to allow wrestling to combine the purchase of warm-ups and uniforms for this fiscal year. They were due to have warm-ups purchased in two years but a decision was made to order both this year in order to save money overall and insure that everything matches. \$3500 has been budgeted this year for wrestling uniforms and wrestling coach has asked if he can purchase both uniforms and warm-ups (scheduled for replacement in 2 years for \$1350) this rotation. Estimate for uniforms is \$1903.20 and warm-ups is \$2158.40, totaling \$4061.60 – \$561.60 over the \$3500 budgeted amount for 2009-10 and about \$788 less than the combined wrestling uniform & warm-up budget of \$4850. Budget was \$4,850 for the two years but the total comes in at \$4,100. This issue will be looked at again in the future when they are due for new uniforms.

**Boys Swim** is still on hold for another month pending assessment of situation with Greenfield. Greenfield's pool is still waiting for windows and needs have not been identified. There are discussions ongoing between the AD's of both schools to determine what is going to be needed. Warm up jackets were asked about. Can the team members purchase them? Where is swim team on the list for uniforms?

- A question came up regarding the purchase of parkas for the swim team several years ago. It appears that they are not being used and there are questions on whether to sell them or not. This will be taken up at our next meeting.

### AD Update – Gina Wilkins

- Fall sports recap – Cross Country had 2 runners qualify for state; Girls swim had 1 swimmer qualify for state and Girls tennis had 3 players qualify for state. Football made the playoffs.
- Winter sports has started with tryouts with Bowling this week. Hockey looks like it will see about 28 players including 6 from Greendale along with a larger JV than anticipated.

- **College Recruiter Jack Renkens** will be at Greendale on March 22, 2010 to discuss what your child needs to know in order to participate in College athletics. Very important to attend if they intend to go out for college sports. Greendale is teaming up with Franklin HS to put on this event.
- There is talk about changes to the Football Conference for Greendale. Voting will happen in January 2010. More to come on this topic in the near future. The new lineup would be:

- **Outdoor Concessions Wrap-up** – Cindy Connell reported that we made approximately \$3,700 for the 2 additional games. The last game used up almost all stock.
- Regarding concessions, there will be a group of 5-6 people needed to take on the task of running concessions. If you are interested, let Johnny Gardetto or Mark Van Ells know. Julie Hall has already indicated that she is interested. We will need the reps to be more active in the overall running of the concessions to be successful.
- **Indoor Concessions** – Karen Rick
  - Johnny will email indoor concession schedule and will then be posted on the booster club website.
  - Johnny expressed concerns to all sport reps to be responsible for coordinating volunteers when necessary. Be aware of the membership list if they have problems finding parents from their sport to fill the needs spots for concessions.
