

**GPABC Minutes
January 13, 2010**

Meeting called to order at 6:33 pm by President Johnny Gardetto.

Opening Statement made by Johnny Gardetto. The GPABC Contact list was routed for attendance and corrections.

December Minutes – Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved Minutes from the meeting on December 9, 2009. Minutes are posted on the website, www.greendaleboosterclub.org.

Johnny reviewed the Boys Swim project selection approved at December's meeting: The warm-up jackets were ordered for both Greendale and Greenfield team members from All American Aquatics. Greenfield will reimburse us for the cost of their boys' jackets. The cost for the jackets is about \$55-60 each, and all of the equipment approved at the December board meeting cost \$1149 instead of the \$1400 originally approved. [If the co-op with Greenfield is ever dissolved, the ADs will meet to discuss how any equipment and uniforms/warm-ups are divided.]

Special Thanks – Received from the Boys' Swim Team: On behalf of the Greendale/Greenfield boys swim team, we would like to thank you for your support in funding our warm up jackets. We realize it was not our year to have warm ups purchased, and appreciate your support in purchasing them. We look forward to everybody having a jacket for conference as well at sectionals and state. It will be great having something warm to wear and looking like a team.

PROJECT SELECTION (Spring Sports) – Gina Wilkins

- **Boys Tennis:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$1180.40** for balls (\$680.40) and court time (not to exceed \$500).
- **Girls Soccer:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$1447.00** for 24 practice and 4 game balls (\$772), 60 practice vests (\$450), and 3 portable training goals (\$225).
- **Girls Softball:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$930.00** for two new catchers' helmets (\$400), jugs and game balls (\$430), and dynabands (\$100).
- **Boys Golf:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$1974.84** for practice rounds of golf (\$800) and golf balls (\$1174.84). No logo will be printed on the golf balls this year to reduce the expense.
- **Boys & Girls Track & Field:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$1380.00** for pole vault helmet, bag, trainer tool and crossbars (\$600), therabands (\$105), shot/disc carriers (\$120), blocks (\$300), rakes (\$140), and high jump crossbars (\$115).
- **Facility:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$150** for two storage carts and hangers. All containers are lockable. Uniforms will now be hung to preserve the lettering/numbering which were damaged when folded.
- **Weight Room:** Motion made, seconded and unanimously approved the cost of **\$725** for 25# plates (\$115), 210# plates (\$360) and a rack to hold the plates (\$250).

Spring sport requests total \$7787.24.

AD UPDATE – Gina Wilkins

Use of Concession Stand: The IFL Panthers and Gridiron Football League South Milwaukee Rage have approached the District to use the turf field this Summer. Teams would play on different nights. Gina is working out the contract details with each group, but neither team would use our concession stand, except for maybe using the coolers. Any money made from the rental of the field goes into the District fund for maintaining the turf.
